Abstract:	A self-taught collector and trader of Egyptian, Greek and Roman antiquities, Giovanni Dattari monopolized the trade of Alexandrian coins in Egypt for decades. At the same time, he put his expertise to the service of the foremost scholars of his time, who greatly benefitted from his first-hand knowledge of the territory. Moreover, he was directly involved in the acquisition of the most important museum collection of Alexandrian coins in the world. His fabled collection of over 13,000 coins, dispersed on the market after 1972, can now be reconstructed in its entirety thanks to the publication by A. Savio of the manuscripts with the supplements to the Catalogue. In the course of the last two years, the ANS was able to acquire 30 coins which were originally part of this fabled collection. These Dattari coins, all specimens of invaluable historical significance, further add to the already outstanding ANS collection of Alexandrian coins that, with over 16,000 coins, is one of the best in the world.

Abstract:	The die study shows that production of posthumous Alexanders continued more or less uninterrupted from the 270s into the 160s BC. Three stylistic groups are observed, which may be related to important events in the history of Magnesia on the Maeander. However, we resist the temptation to impose a fixed correlation between events and issues, given the general character of these coins. A relative chronology is nonetheless proposed, which further supports earlier studies of coin circulation in the second century BC between Asia Minor and the Seleukid empire. Finally, the article refocuses attention on the centrality of Magnesia-on-the-Maeander in the economy and politics of the Maeander Valley region.

Abstract:	Ptolemy II Philadelphus transformed his bronze coinage in the mid- to late-260s BC by introducing new designs, very large sizes and weights, new denominations and new manufacturing technology . These changes took place in parallel at Alexandria and at least three of Egypt's provincial mints on the Phoenician coast. The coinage changes and their geographical span define the Bronze Coinage Reform of Ptolemy II (the Reform), long known to scholars of Ptolemaic coinage.

Abstract:	Epigraphic mentions of denarii were initially limited to strongly Romanized contexts and government-related documents. These inscriptions began to appear in Asia right after the end of the civil wars, before the so-called διόρθωμα of Augustus in Thessaly and just after the οἰκτῶβολος εἰσφορὰ in Messenia. There are only a few epigraphic attestations of the use of Roman currency in private contexts before the 2nd century AD. This sporadic epigraphic presence is matched by a scarcity of Roman silver from contemporary hoards, all of which is consistent with the view that Roman currency was largely absent from everyday life in the province.

Abstract:	Mark Antony was defeated at the battle of Actium in 31 BC, but several of his monetary and other innovations were retained by Octavian and his successors. The homage to women of the imperial families on civic bronze coinage, the change in the iconography of provincial silver coinage and the convergence

between Roman and Greek bronze monetary systems are just some of the long-lasting innovations introduced by the triumvir into the Roman monetary system. Even the dynastic strategy enacted by Antony in this coinage and the relevance given to Egypt were further pursued by his former rival. Far from being only a prostrate and submissive victim of Cleopatra's charms, Antony proved to have a clear vision of the future relationships between East and West.

Title:	Money and power: the disappearance of autonomous silver issues in the Roman Province of Asia / Lucia Francesca Carbone

Abstract:	The standardization process of Asian civic silver coinage that took place during the Augustan Age finds its origins in the attitude that the Roman administration adopted towards civic issues right from the institution of the Provincia Asia in the 120s BC. Through our study of Asian autonomous silver issues, we will demonstrate that Romans were much more involved in the silver coinages of the Asian cities than any previous power dominating the area, as is suggested by the Roman names present on these issues and the evident decrease in the number of cities issuing them after the Roman province of Asia was instituted. Another element hinting at Roman intervention is the fact that the circulation of autonomous silver issues was limited to Caria and Rhodes, regions which were bestowed freedom and special privileges after the First Mithridatic War and maintained these privileges even afterwards. Asian autonomous issues only became fully integrated into the local monetary system during Augustan times through their linkage to the denarius and the cistophorus standards, but this process had already started during the course of the 2nd century BC. After a brief introduction of Augustan policy towards Asian non-autonomous silver coinage, this paper will provide a survey of the changes in the production and circulation of Asian autonomous silver issues under Roman dominion up to the Augustan Age, and will show how these changes were deeply intertwined with a gradual increase in Roman political control over the province of Asia from the beginning of the Roman period.

Abstract:	The dating, function, and iconography of Roman lead tokens from Spain, usually described as plomos, have been an object of speculation among scholars since the eighteenth century. The great majority of these tokens have been found in the Spanish regions of Córdoba and Sevilla, an area known in Roman times for the presence of silver mines and for the production of olive oil. It seems likely that they were used to supplement the supply of Roman and local coinage available in the area. The Richard B. Witschonke Collection (RBW) at the American Numismatic Society includes fourteen specimens of these tokens, five of which are published here for the first time in a comprehensive way.

Abstract:	The aureus of Postumus (RIC 260) kept in the Ossolineum is an extremely valuable piece. It was acquired to the Ossoliński National Institute collection between c. 1846 and 1902, most probably from a local find from the territory of the eastern part of the Kingdom of Galicia and Lodomeria, at that time part of Austrian Empire (today's western Ukraine). The piercing of the coin is a clear indication that it was reused in the Barbaricum as a pendant. Its owner could be a certain *Gunþijaz, the chieftain of the ingentia auxilia formations allied.

Abstract: In 2011 metal detectorists discovered a hoard of 62 porcupine/standard sceattas and nine Merovingian deniers near Cothen (Utrecht). In several respects this find is exceptional. The porcupine sceattas have been struck on a low weight standard. They belong to imitative sub-varieties. Most of the coins have a test-cut, which is something almost unknown in the Netherlands and England. The hoard was most likely concealed around 730-740. The presence of six deniers from Metz, and stylistic resemblances to a group of porcupine sceattas tentatively attributed to northern France or Belgium point to this region as the possible place of production. This would indicate that porcupine sceattas played a role in the monetary circulation of the north-eastern Merovingian lands. The test-cuts, however, could indicate that the hoard has originally been formed in Northern Germany or Scandinavia.

One portion of this collection, purchased by the ANS from Ramsden, can be traced back to the Chinese antiquarian and official Luo Zhenyu (1866-1940).

Abstract:	Runners crave the medals qua recognition for their effort but, in the last decades, qua objects, as well. Abstract:	Die cutter and silversmith Juriaan Pool (c. 1618-1669) came from Silesia to Amsterdam, where he settled in the early 1650s. In 1651 he married Margareta Schots, originally from Moers, with whom he got nine children. The next year he became poorter (citizen) of Amsterdam and so he was allowed to become a member of the gold- and silversmiths guild. From then on he was able to officially work as a silversmith and could integrate quite well as a craftsman in seventeenth-century Amsterdam. Pool seems to have developed a wide network within the city; acquiring commissions, working with colleagues and training a number of apprentices. Five contracts are still in the Amsterdam City Archives. Nicolaas Mensma, Boudewijn Sijmens, Jan François van Peperzeele, Eide Andeles I and Jean Ailkens van Driel all studied with Pool between 1658 and 1666. This article also discusses the possible master to whom Pool himself was apprenticed. The inventory of Pool's estate, compiled after he died in 1669, holds much information on his acquaintances and his working methods. Pool was mainly a die cutter, but he also chased and embossed. His currently known oeuvre consists of fifteen different struck medals, three plaquettes and a beaker. All of these objects were signed by Pool with his name or initials, but his maker's mark has not (yet) been identified. Most of the dies made by Pool seem to have been made in commission, while the medals were subsequently produced by other silversmiths. In 1666 Pool was commissioned by Frederick William I, Elector of Brandenburg, to cut dies for thirteen coins for the city of Kleve. These are still to be identified, hopefully in the near future.
